

 The major factor determining the timing and strength of recovery is the national outlook
- CA has seen above average job losses and unemployment increases during the recession
- The reason is our huge construction losses
- Ex construction future growth will outpace the nation but the construction recovery will lag and restrain near term growth


The National Forecast is the Key Driver for California

Unemployment Rates




Construction Explains CA's Below Average Job Performance

Where Future Job Growth Will Occur


- Why is there so much focus on manufacturing when high wage job growth will be elsewhere?

Manufacturing is not the Answer


- Manufacturing jobs in the nation and state, though important, will probably be lower in 2020 than in 2008.
- High wage job growth will be in professional services, Internet related activities and the application of creativity to new goods and services. Trade and tourism will be the other economic base growth sectors.
- These sectors should be the focus of the state's competitiveness strategies.

Manufacturing Job Losses Everywhere






Manufacturing Job Losses in Recession
